



Colours can sway thinking and emotions. Colours are irreplaceable. To bring positivity, colour week was celebrated with great enthusiasm.





In the mirror's gaze, a face unknown A life caught between, not quite grown Dreams like whispers, hopes so bright Navigating shadows, seeking light


The clock ticks loud, a hurried race In hallways loud, they find their place Books and notes, the endless test, Striving hard, to be the best
